Free School Meals & Pupil Premium

Not to be confused with the Universal Free School Meals, it is vital that all pupils who are eligible to claim 'Free School Meals' are registered in order for schools to receive their Pupil Premium funding.

The 'Free Schools Meals Application Form' can be completed online via the Cornwall Council website: [Apply for free school meals and pupil premium - Cornwall Council](#)

If your child is eligible for Free School Meals it comes with benefits like free access to the infant Breakfast Club and the school may also cover/contribute to clubs/trips. It is a worthwhile thing to apply for, even if you don't think you will be eligible.

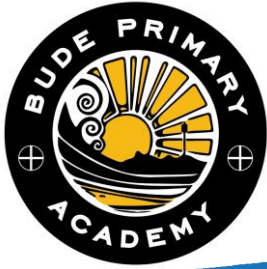
After school clubs
